FTMS College was awarded the high rating of 'Tier 5: Excellent' in the College-Based Category on the Malaysian Quality Evaluation System for Private College (MyQUEST) 2012/2013, by the Ministry of Education Malaysia (MOE). In addition, the College also achieved a 6 Star (Outstanding) rating for the General Programme and International Students Readiness Rating clusters and a 5 Star (Excellent) rating for Science Mathematics and Computing & Social Sciences Business and Law clusters.

FTMS is truly honoured to have been awarded the distinguished rating of 'Tier 5: Excellent; in the Malaysian Quality Evaluation System for Private Colleges MyQUEST 2012/2013, by the Ministry of Education. This award is a feather in the FTMS cap a seal of excellence on the quality of all programmes offered by FTMS.

Introduced in 2011, MyQUEST (Malaysian Quality Evaluation System for Private Colleges) is used to evaluate private colleges in Malaysia in terms of the quality of students, programmes, graduates, resources and governance. The MyQUEST rating categorises institutions outstanding, excellent, very good, good or poor. Institutions also receive a rating based on their level of achievement ranging from 1 Star (poor) to 6 Stars (outstanding).

FTMS decided immediately following the first MyQUEST result announcement, MyQUEST 2011/2012, that the college should focus solely on the provision of quality education and student experience. The education sector demands high quality student services, in an environment that is continuously enhancing requirements and the emergence of new competitors.

The government has progressively undertaken various initiatives and programmes to improve the education industry and its services. In line with the goal of making Malaysia as an education hub, FTMS underlined its objectives to privide a quality education and student services to the students.

MyQUEST 2012/2013 measures the quality of a private college according to its 'Input' (quality of students and resources). 'Output' (programme recognition and graduate recognition), and the Quality Management System of the college.

Malaysia has more than 400 private colleges of which 211 were qualified to be evaluated.

As well as the 5 Star rating for the college, FTMS scored the following ratings for the four clusters audited:

- General Programme 6\*
- International Students 6\*
- Science, Mathematics and Computing 5\*
- Social Science, Business and Law 5\*
