The MOU confirms the connecting of both countries through the formation of a strategic collaboration in the promotion and strategic capacity building for Yemen. Using the vast experience gained from over thirty (30) years within education FTMS will provide students from Yemen with the necessary skills in areas selected by the Ministry at both Undergraduate and Postgraduate levels.

In recognition of the support extended to FTMS by the government of Yemen FTMS confirmed the availability of a total of eighteen scholarships for students from Yemen.
