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New Academia of FTMS at TPM

For the past 26 years, FTMS College has been continuously providing quality academic and professional courses from the deliberately selected location in the bustling city centre of Kuala Lumpur. This August, FTMS College will cross the threshold to a new milestone with a brand new campus in Technology Park Malaysia.

The new campus will be hosting the college's undergraduate and post-graduate franchise degree programmes from the United Kingdom in a threestorey building with a urbanized area of 200,000 square feet, sprawling across five acres of land in Technology Park Malaysia.

The college's principal Mr. Sajilal Divakaran, states that they are intending to commence their new academic programmes on 1st August 2012 with 1,000 undergraduate and post-graduate students.

FTMS College is well known for its affiliation with universities in the United Kingdom, such as the University of East London (UEL), Anglia Ruskin University (ARU), the University of Portsmouth and Oxford Brookes University, who offer programmes at both Bachelors and Masters Degree level.

Their current undergraduate programmes include Software Engineering, Accounting and Finance, Business Information Systems, International Management and their postgraduate programmes embrace Computer Systems and Engineering, Business Administration, Information Technology and Software Engineering.

There were notable words given by the General Manager Mr Sajilal Divakaran who stated, "We will be running a number of new programmes on computing courses from UEL and various business and finance courses from ARU. We will also having a new collaboration with the Leeds Metropolitan University, to offer Bachelor and Master Degrees in its Engineering programmes and its Hospitality and Tourism programmes".

Mr. Sajilal also states that FTMS College believes that UK education is more reliable, and has assured quality.

FTMS College's new home - the Technology Park Malaysia (TPM), is the country's most sophisticated and widespread centre solely for research and development for knowledge-based industries. It has a total land area of 750 acres and comprises 12 state-of-the-art buildings where each comes with specific functions.

The new campus, being a part of the vivacious and green technology hub, it will be well equipped with numerous amenities such as a large library, centres for internal and external college activities and a range of sports facilities like squash, badminton, futsal and gym. There will be twenty classrooms capable of hosting between 20 to 90 students and well-equipped laboratories.

Mr. Sajilal added that RM12 million has been invested for the new campus as FTMS works towards becoming an MSC-status organisation to go with its ISO certification. "The college also provides shuttle services from LRT stations to the campus for the students and the staff. We have also arranged hostel accommodations nearby especially for our international students," the general manager declared.

FTMS College currently has 1,200 International students, which are close to 50 per cent of the student's population from more than 42 countries who are pursuing their tertiary studies at diploma, bachelor degree and master degree levels.

Student Accommodation is available close by the campus is self catering units. A Scheduled shuttle service between the Bukit Jalil LRT station and the campus is also available for those who live further away from Technology Park Malaysia Campus.









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Specialized courses are the new enlargement in response to what the market desires

As the new campus can accommodate 3,000 to 4,000 students, Mr. Sajilal says that there are a lot of potentials for growth in student numbers. "We are looking forward to augment the figure to 2,000 to 2,500 students in the subsequent year and we also plan to offer more courses, especially in engineering and hospitality courses.

Based on their market research, there are emerging demands for electrical and civil engineers as well as hospitality and tourism management in Malaysia. The college is offering bachelors degree for those respective fields of study which augment their areas of expertise In addition internships with 15 reputable hotels in Malaysia for Hospitality and Tourism Management graduates has been organised.



Mr. Sajilal added that the college is also looking to commence a few more innovative courses such as computer network, mobile communication, information security and forensic computing.

"These are the promising fields in the U.K. and U.S. Some of the universities in Malaysia have started these programs but hey are not well established yet, as one needs resources and facilities to support the courses," expressed the principal. FTMS College is scheduling to start these undergraduate programs next February with UEL, which is currently offering these programs in its university in the UK.

"Such specialized courses are the new growth ares in response to what the market desires. Above and beyond, the young people these days are much focused and are motivated to go for a field that will benefit the market and society." he further adds. With a prominence on education that meets the market's demand, Mr. Sajilal affirmed the employability rate for FTMS graduates to be around 95 per cent.

He also acknowledged that the qualities of graduates are important, and that the courses offered help to mould the scholars to be capable and employable. He also claimed that their modules are mostly practical-based and that the college's academic staff encompasses with extensive industrial experience.

He also proclaimed that the current 5-story building with 60,000 square feet in Jalan Hang Kasturi will continue to host the professional courses, diploma courses, foundation and English courses.



FTMS College, which is currently franchised in 12 countries in Asia and Africa is foremost established and well known as an institution that offers professional courses. It has a very strong foundation in the Chartered Institute of Management Accountants (CIMA), the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA) and the Confederation of Tourism and Hospitality (CTH). "Many of the 1,200 students pursuing these qualifications are part-timers and the city-centre location is convenient for them", he stated.
